The words 'Christian' and 'Christianity' came from the name, Jesus **Christ**.

Who was Jesus?

Christians believe Jesus was fully human.

Why is this important to Christians?

Jesus being fully human meant he lived a life being vulnerable as other humans do and felt pain in the same way as other humans.

Jesus was crucified and died on the cross. Jesus rose from the dead on the third day.

As Jesus was fully human, his torture before his death would have caused him pain. This is significant for Christians because Jesus' suffering is what they believe frees them from sin

— he took the burden of their sin.



Who was Jesus?

When Jesus was around 30 years old, he started teaching large groups of people and performing miracles. He was baptised in the Jordan River by the prophet known as John the Baptist.

For about three years, Jesus travelled with 12 appointed disciples (also known as the 12 apostles). Some of the most well-known miraculous events or 'miracles' included raising a dead man named Lazarus from the grave, walking on water and curing the blind. Jesus was put to death by **crucifixion** when he was 33 years old.

Beliefs

Christians believe in one God.

However, Christians believe that God is 3 separate but constant persons:







Holy Spirit

Christians believe that God is **Father**, **Son** and **Holy Spirit** quite separately but all at the same time. This is called the **Trinity**. To some people this can be quite a confusing idea.

That Jesus is the Son of God

That Jesus was sent to save people from their sins

That Jesus was the Messiah who had been promised in the Old Testament
