How does my child learn times tables in school?

- 1. Repeated addition
- 2. Skip counting e.g. songs
- 4. Break it down into manageable chunks and introduce tips and tricks e.g. 9s, 8s, 11s,
 - Key facts
 - Next door facts
 - Brain busters
- 5. Games, repetition and spaced recall to build fluency and speed:
 - o card games (pelmanism, hide and seek, say the answer, say the question, splat the answer, splat the question, speed quiz)
 - o timed quizes (mad maths minutes)
 - o speed write
 - o Leitner method
 - o online Games: Hit the Button/ EdShed/ MathsFrame
 - o class games Around the World, Bingo
 - exit questions
- 6. Commutative law/ Fact Families
